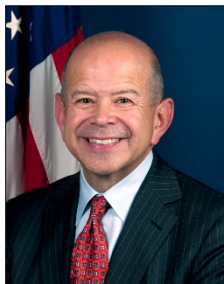

Michael P. Huerta is the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration. Since being sworn into office in 2013, Huerta's efforts have encompassed a variety of improvements including the modernization of air traffic control through integration of the NextGen program, integration of unmanned aircraft systems, transitioning from radar to GPS radio stations, repeal of the ban on personal electronic devices aboard airplanes, an increased focus on safety data, and the development and execution of a new registration system designed to provide safety information.
