


## **EXECUTIVE PROFILE**

SAMUEL JOHNSON IBTTA Immediate Past President *CEO, Transportation Corridor Agencies* 



Samuel Johnson serves as CEO for the Transportation Corridor Agencies (TCA) -- two joint powers authorities formed by the California legislature in 1986 to plan, finance, construct and operate Orange County's public toll road system.

Prior to joining TCA in 2015 a Chief Toll Operations Officer, Johnson spent 12 years with the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) overseeing countywide efforts to implement innovative transportation solutions and serving as

part of the executive team responsible for the region's tolling enterprise, including the State Route 125 toll road and the I-15 Express Lanes, the nation's first dynamically priced toll facility.

Johnson has a rounded perspective for tolling being trained as an accountant and having worked in transit and advanced technology for nearly two decades. He is a member of the IBTTA Board of Directors, currently serving as Immediate Past President. During his presidency, Johnson was instrumental in establishing the Leadership Academy Alumni Association and the Toll Immersion Program for internships. He also founded the Task Force on Diversity, Social, and Racial Inclusion to implement practices and programs that contribute to racial and social justice within IBTTA and beyond.

Before being appointed to IBTTA's Executive Committee, Johnson participated on the Finance, Membership and Interoperability Governance committees and contributed to the IBTTA TollMiner<sup>TM</sup> Working Group.

A past president of the statewide California Toll Operators Committee (CTOC), Johnson earned a bachelor's of science degree in business management with an emphasis in accounting from San Diego State University.
