Chief Executive Officer, Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission



Mark P. Compton began serving as chief executive officer of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission (PTC) in Middletown, Pa., on Feb. 1, 2013. As CEO, Mark steers an 80-year-old organization comprised of 552 miles of toll roads and more than 1,300 employees statewide. In fiscal year 2020, the PTC collected nearly \$1.3 billion in toll revenues generated by 190.5 million vehicles.

A professional with more than two decades of public and private-sector experience in transportation, administration, government affairs, and construction, Mark holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Penn State University, State College, Pa.

Before joining the PTC, Mark served as deputy secretary of administration for PennDOT in Harrisburg, Pa., overseeing eight bureaus within the agency. Before joining PennDOT, Mark was director of government affairs for American Infrastructure, a heavy civil construction company in Worcester, Pa. Prior to that, he worked in various public and private operations, focusing largely on transportation, construction, and economic development.

Since 2015, Mark has served on IBTTA's Board of Directors including serving as chair of the Government Affairs Committee and as a member of the Awards Committee. Mark served as president in 2021 and is currently serving the association as immediate past president.

Mark resides with his wife, MacKenzie, in Manheim (Lancaster County, Pa.) along with his four children.
