Road Usage Charging & Finance Conference

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021 signed into law by President Biden holds the promise of making historic investments in America's roads, bridges and rails, tackling the climate crisis, advancing environmental justice, and investing in communities that have often been left behind. However, despite this new legislation, stabilizing the revenue stream to support transportation infrastructure is still problematic. Auto manufactures have pledged to move rapidly toward producing only electric vehicles. This means that fuel tax revenues will continue to decline, leaving the highway trust funds of the states and federal government depleted and at great risk. In this environment, states are moving to alternative methods of paying for road infrastructure, including tolling and road usage charging (also known as VMT or MBUF). The policies, technology, marketing, communications, public acceptance, implementation and operation of tolling, pricing, and RUC are converging. During this conference, we will look at case studies, best practices, and lessons learned from successful and unsuccessful implementations of tolling and RUC all over the world. We will also explore the convergence of tolling and RUC.
