FACULTY

The IBTTA Foundation Leadership Academy Executive Development Program is directed by Lindsey Robertson-Lentz and a team of transportation leadership development professionals from Evans Consulting. HOW TO APPLY

Nominees must complete an application form and submit a resume and a recommendation or endorsement from the leadership of your organization. The application form is online at www.IBTTA.org/leadershipacademy.

ADMISSIONS

Toll agency executive directors and business partner executives are invited to nominate candidates for the IBTTA Leadership Academy Executive Development Program. Lindsey Robertson-Lentz, program director, will review the applications and select up to 40 participants. The selection process will ensure a balanced class that represents the tolling industry.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The deadline to apply for admission is **October 31, 2025**.

TUITION

The fee for the program is \$4,150. Tuition includes all course materials, breakfast each morning, four lunches and two dinners. Tuition is non-refundable after **December 31, 2025**. Tuition fees must be paid by **Friday, February 6, 2026**.
